



2014 State of the Village: By The Numbers

Economic & Community Development

- 28 net new businesses
- 100 cars featured each week between 5/29 - 8/28 at Cruise Nights
- 120 artists displayed work at Barrington Art Festival
- 89 merchants participated in Barrington Scarecrow Festival, with record attendance
- 47 merchants participated in Barrington Holiday Sweepstakes
- 21 shops and 8 restaurants participated in merchant-led Holiday Wine Walks
- 21,000 Calendar of Events distributed to area residents
- 5,000 Shopping and Dining Guides distributed
- 500 tickets were sold to the Oscar Short Films at the Catlow Theater

Public Works

- 28th year named as a Tree City USA
- 46 trees planted; 1,368 parkway trees trimmed; 610 dead trees (552 Ash) removed
- 1,800 tons of recyclable material collected
- 16,500 linear feet of sanitary sewer pipe cleaned
- 635 yards of wood chips chipped
- 978 fire hydrants received annual maintenance
- 29 snow and ice events handled



Police

- 285 cases heard from Administrative Adjudication process, including 83 cases stemming from parking violations.
- 4.8 on a 5 point scale customer satisfaction for Barrington Police Department
- 9,243 calls for service handled by Barrington Police
- 595 traffic accidents handled
- Installed 49 child safety seats
- Awarded two vehicles valued at more than \$41,000 in cash from court ordered property forfeitures
- Supported and coordinated services for many local events intended to foster economic and community development

Development Services

- 1.36 miles of Village Streets improved
- 940 yards of pavement patch
- \$17.5 million in additional Route 14 underpass funding secured
- 3,700 linear feet of water main and 611 linear feet of storm sewer replaced
- 1,578 building permits reviewed, approved and issued
- Over 2,500 building inspections completed
- \$327,600 of ICC Grants distributed to residents for individual CN noise mitigation projects



Community & Financial Services & Human Resources

- 8.96% increase in sales tax receipts for 2014
- 6,163 walk-in customers and 10,372 phone-in customers served
- 30th year in a row receiving the Certificate of Achievement in Financial Reporting Award
- 11th year in a row receiving the Distinguished Budget Presentation Award
- Barrington's Bond Rate is Aa1 (Moody's)
- Taxpayers received a savings of \$1,252,101 from refinancing since 2009
- Maintained risk management by working to reduce work-related accidents resulting in holding the cost of claims to 64% less than the 5-year average and significantly lower than the risk management target that was set.

Fire and EMS

- 1,749 total calls received by Barrington Fire Department with an average of 4.8 daily call volume
- 644 of the total calls were alarms or good intent service calls, and 27 other calls included cooking, appliance, vehicle, grass, or dumpster fires
- 1,078 of the total calls were for emergency medical calls, including 343 refusals of treatment or transport
- 792 fire inspections
- 8,527 hours of training
- 4 to 2 ISO rating improvement
