**New Business**

**Project Updates**

Ms. Nye provided an overview of the various projects pedestrian and bicyclist related projects in the Village. An update on the Grove Avenue/Dundee Road improvement was discussed in detail. The project is fully designed and scheduled for 2019 construction, but due to state funding the project may be pushed back. The future improvements on Hart Road and Route 14 were also discussed. Several private development improvements were discussed including new sidewalk connections to Roslyn Road School, a new multiuse path near Prairie Middle School and bicycle lockers and storage at the new apartment building on Liberty Street. Finally, the Village was invited to attend the Illinois Route 62 Phase I Study. Ms. Nye provided information handouts to the Committee and discussed the future improvements in this area. Committee Person Clark brought up the Ela Road and Long Grove Road project. Although this project is being handled by Lake County Department of Transportation, The Village of Barrington is effected by the improvements. Ms. Nye stated that she will bring more information on the project to share with

the Committee at the next meeting.

**Crash Data**

Ms. Nye explained that crash data was requested from the Police Department related to bicycle and pedestrian crashes. The Police Department was able to share the raw data for all pedestrian and bicycle related crashes from the past three years. Ms. Nye completed an initial analysis which showed that the crashes were spread out through many intersections in the Village and did not indicate one problem location. The Committee reviewed all eighteen crashes carefully and discussed potential safety improvements to decrease future accidents. The Committee discussed requesting IDOT crash data in order to receive even more information on local crashes. Ms. Nye suggested an article in the newsletter on pedestrian and bicycle tips could be helpful at the beginning of the spring.
