Andrew Binder, Planning & Zoning Coordinator made a short presentation about bicycle and pedestrian planning and the Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Plan update.

The public provided feedback on a number of issues relating to bike and pedestrian related issues. The attendees were particularly concerned with the completion of sidewalk gaps throughout the Village, installation of additional bike racks throughout the Village, installation of new crosswalks at key intersections particularly on Rt. 59 between Main St. and Rt. 14, connections to area Forest Preserves and prioritizing new connections and enhancements to existing connections that serve schools.
