

## 652 S. Cook Street – Noncontributing



This is a one-story, frame, rectangular plan, Minimal Traditional style dwelling built ca. 1950. The dwelling has a continuous poured concrete foundation, a hipped roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of aluminum siding and an interior central brick chimney. On the main (E) façade is a partial-width, inset porch with a poured concrete floor and wrought iron rails. The main entrance retains its original single-light and three-wood panel door with a glass and aluminum storm door. Windows are original, one-over-one and two-over-two horizontal-sash double hung wood sash. On the main façade is a single-light picture window flanked by two-over-two horizontal-light double hung sash windows.



Located to the rear of the dwelling is a one-story, single-bay, frame garage built ca. 1955 with a side gable roof of asphalt shingles, a continuous poured concrete foundation, weatherboard siding, four-light fixed windows, a hollow-core wood pedestrian door and an original, twelve wood panel overhead track door. **Noncontributing**
