141 Coolidge Avenue – Contributing



Located at 141 Coolidge Avenue is a one-and one-half story Folk dwelling built ca. 1910 with a gable front main section and a one-story lateral wing on the east façade. The house has a gable roof of asphalt shingles, an interior brick chimney, an added exterior wall brick chimney, an exterior of aluminum siding and a rock-faced concrete block continuous foundation. On the main (N) façade is a hipped roof porch with ca. 1970, square wood columns and a square wood baluster railing. The main entrance has a ca. 1970, multi-light glass and wood door. On the west façade is a secondary entrance with a glass and wood door and a ca. 1970, shed roof canopy supported by square wood posts and railing. Windows are original one-over-one and two-over-two vertical-light double hung wood sash and replacement, ca. 1990, one over-one double hung aluminum sash.

To the rear of the dwelling is a ca. 1970 frame garage. **Noncontributing**
