

205 Coolidge Avenue – Noncontributing



ARC 12-03 – ARC recommended reclassification of structures from contributing to noncontributing status.

Located at 205 Coolidge Avenue is a small, frame, side-gabled one-story Folk cottage built ca. 1930. The cottage has a roof of asphalt shingles, an interior brick chimney, a continuous stone-faced concrete block foundation and an exterior of synthetic siding. The full-width, inset porch on the main (N) façade has been enclosed with synthetic siding and sliding track vinyl clad windows with flanking vinyl shutters. The main entrance has an original, three-horizontal-light and three-horizontal wood panel door which lead to wood steps with PVC railings. Windows are single-light casement design and one-over-one double hung wood sash.

Off the southwest corner of the dwelling is an original, frame garage with a front gable roof of asphalt shingles, horizontal board siding and vertical board hinged double doors. **Noncontributing.**
