

## 221 Coolidge Avenue – Contributing



Located at 221 West Coolidge Avenue is a one- and one-half story, frame, side-gabled Craftsman dwelling built ca. 1925. The dwelling has a roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of aluminum siding and a continuous foundation of rock-faced concrete blocks. On the main (N) façade is a full-width porch which was enclosed with aluminum jalousie windows and aluminum siding ca. 1970. The main entrance has a ca. 1970, eight-light glass and wood Craftsman-style door flanked by single-light glass and wood sidelights. Windows are original, six-over-one double hung wood sash. In the eaves are purloins and exposed eave roof rafters. At the roofline on the main façade is a gabled roof dormer with paired, three-over-one double hung wood sash windows, exposed roof rafter ends and purloins.



Located to the rear of the dwelling is an original, two-bay, side gable roof garage with a side gable roof of asphalt shingle, an exterior of board and batten siding and two, replacement overhead track metal panel garage doors. **Contributing**
