

302 E. Hillside Avenue – Noncontributing



Located at 302 Hillside Avenue is a one-story, side-gabled Minimal Traditional style dwelling built ca. 1950. The dwelling has a side gable roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior end brick chimney, an exterior of brick veneer and a continuous concrete foundation. The main entrance has a ca. 1980, oval-light and wood door with milled wood railings, milled wood posts and spindled frieze above which is a gable roof entry canopy with gable returns. On the main façade is an original, twenty-five light glass and wood picture window slightly bowed with a wood base. Windows are two-over-two horizontal-light double hung wood sash. On the east façade is an original side gable roof garage attached via an enclosed side gable roof breezeway. The breezeway has been enclosed with double-panel windows and an entry with a glass and aluminum door. The yard perimeter is outlined with a white picket fence with wood posts and brass round knobs.
