

## 215 E. Lincoln Avenue – Contributing



Located at 215 East Lincoln Avenue is a one- and one-half story asymmetrical Folk dwelling built ca. 1915. The dwelling has a hip and gable roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of aluminum siding, a continuous poured concrete foundation and an exterior end aluminum-sided chimney. On the main (W) façade is a ca. 1960, incised porch with a concrete block foundation, square wood posts and a wood railing. Over one of the two entries is a gable roof canopy with aluminum siding in the gable field. Two entries are located on the main façade. One entry has a ca. 1940, single-light and four-wood panel door while the secondary entrance has a two-horizontal-light glass and wood panel door. Both doorways have glass and aluminum storm doors. Windows are original, one-over-one double hung wood sash with aluminum-covered surrounds and flanked by vinyl shutters. On the main (W) façade is a paired set of three-light metal casement windows. A small, gable roof addition is located on the rear façade.

Off the southwest corner of the dwelling is a one-bay, frame, ca. 1930, garage with a hipped roof of asphalt shingles and original twenty-wood panel overhead track door flanked by vinyl shutters. **Contributing**
