

115 Harrison Street – Contributing



ARC 02-08 – exterior modifications (preliminary review only)

At 115 N. Harrison Street is a two-story, rectangular American Foursquare plan dwelling built ca. 1910. The dwelling has a continuous rusticated concrete foundation, a hipped roof of asphalt shingles and an exterior of weatherboard siding. On the main (W) façade is an original, full-width, hipped roof porch with square wood columns, a closed weatherboard railing and a wood floor on concrete block piers. The main entrance retains its original, single-light glass and wood panel door with an aluminum storm door. Flanking the main entrance on the north is a single-light fixed window with a wood surround. On the north façade is a secondary entrance with a recessed, single-light and four-wood panel door. Some of the original, two-light glass and wood awning basement windows remain. On the main façade roofline is a triangular dormer with an original three-light glass and wood awning window with a wood surround and weatherboard siding.
