

125 Harrison Street – Contributing



At this location is a one-and-one-half story side-gabled Folk dwelling built ca. 1915 and extensively remodeled ca. 1990 for use as a commercial building. The building has a continuous stucco foundation, a roof of asphalt shingles and an exterior of vinyl siding. On the main façade is a ca. 1990, two-light and metal panel door with a closed pediment and a vinyl surround. Windows are three-over-one vertical-light with vinyl surrounds some with vinyl sash and some with original wood sash. At the roofline is an original, gable roof dormer with a triple set of three-over-one vertical-light vinyl windows.

To the rear of the building is a hipped roof garage with original, three-over-one vertical-light double hung wood sash windows, a hollow core wood pedestrian door on the west facade and a ca. 1980, twenty-panel metal overhead track door on the north facade. **Noncontributing**
