

## 516 S. Grove Avenue – Contributing



**ARC 05-15** – two-story addition on the rear (west) side of the existing structure

At this location is a two-story side-gabled Craftsman dwelling built ca. 1900. The dwelling has an ashlar-faced concrete block foundation, a roof of asphalt shingles with added skylights, an interior central brick chimney and an exterior of aluminum siding. On the main (W) façade is a partial-width, projecting gable roof porch with a closed frame railing covered with aluminum siding and square wood columns. Also on the main façade are a replacement, two-light, fixed window, a eight-light awning window flanking the entrance and a single-light fixed rectangular window on the upper floor. Other windows in the dwelling include four-light casement windows with wood cornice surrounds. On the rear façade is a two-story, gable addition with an exterior of vinyl siding and four-light casement windows. On the south façade is an original, lateral wing with a shed roof, an exterior of aluminum siding. Knee brace brackets and original, half-timbering and stucco are in the gable fields.

Off the southwest corner of the dwelling is ca. 1930, frame, single bay garage with a hipped roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of aluminum siding and a ca. 1970, thirty-two metal panel overhead track door. **Contributing**
