

548 S. Grove Avenue – Contributing



At this location is a one- and one-half-story, gabled ell Folk dwelling built ca. 1900. The house has a brick and stucco foundation, a gable roof of asphalt shingles, an interior brick flue and an exterior of vinyl siding. On the main façade, the original partial-width porch has been removed and replaced with a river rock walkway and stoop leading up to a ca. 1990, six-aluminum panel door with an aluminum and glass storm door. Windows are original, two-over-two double hung wood sash with wood cornice surrounds and fixed vinyl shutters. On the rear façade of the dwelling is a ca. 1970, large, gable roof addition with an exterior end vinyl-clad chimney and skylights at the roofline.

To the rear of the dwelling is a ca. 1970, single-bay, frame garage with an exterior of aluminum siding and an overhead track metal panel door. **Noncontributing**
