

601 S. Grove Avenue – Contributing



At this location is a one-and a half story gabled ell Craftsman dwelling built ca. 1935. The house has an asphalt shingle roof with a projecting gable bay on the main (W) elevation. The house has a poured concrete foundation, an exterior wall brick chimney and an exterior of brick veneer. At the roofline of the main façade is a large gable roof dormer with two three-over-one vertical light sash windows and an exterior of weatherboard siding. The dwelling's projecting gable bay on the main elevation has an incised entry porch with a square brick corner column. The main entrance has a three-light glass and wood door. The windows in the dwelling are original and replacement three-over-one vertical light wood sash. The house has knee brace brackets at the eaves.

At the rear is an original one-and a half story, frame two-car garage with a hipped roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of weatherboard siding and paneled wood overhead track garage doors.

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
