

614 S. Grove Avenue – Contributing



ARC 07-08 – window replacement and front porch column replacement

At this location is a two-story, frame rectangular Italianate dwelling built ca. 1880. The house has a hipped roof of asphalt shingles, an interior central brick chimney and an exterior of weatherboard siding. On the main (E) façade is a full-width shed roof porch with square inset wood panel columns, paired wood brackets at the cornice and a wood floor. The main entrance has a wood panel door with flanking shutters and a wood cornice lentil. Windows are original, four-over-four double hung wood sash. The doors and windows have simple wood cornice lentils and flanking louvered shutters on the main facade. On the north elevation, the first story has a projecting bay with four, four-over-four wood sash windows. On the rear façade is an original, single-story wing with an added second story ca. 1970. Paired wood brackets are located in the dwelling's cornice.



Adjacent to the house is a ca. 1939, two-bay, frame garage with a hipped roof of asphalt shingles, an exterior of vertical board siding and sliding track vertical board doors. **Contributing**
