

655 S. Grove Avenue – Noncontributing



At this location is a two-story, frame, Colonial Revival style dwelling ca. 1940. The house is a gabled ell-with wing, the wing being the garage on the left side. The house has an added poured concrete foundation, a large exterior end brick chimney and an exterior of replacement weatherboard siding. On the main (W) elevation is a gable roof entry porch with a gable pediment with modillion blocks and large Tuscan wood columns. The main entrance has a ca. ca.1980, wood panel door. Windows in the dwelling are original, eight-over-eight and eight-over-twelve double hung wood sash. The dwelling's cornice has modillion blocks and a circular louvered wood vent in the front gable field. On the north façade is an original, one-and one-half-story, frame garage with a side facing gambrel roof, and exterior of replacement vinyl siding and a gable roof dormer with a six-over-six wood sash window. On the first floor of the garage's main façade is a single-bay with an original eight-wood panel overhead track door and an adjacent recessed pedestrian entrance with a nine-light glass and wood door.
