

201 W. Main Street – Contributing



At this location is a two-story, frame, gabled ell Folk dwelling built ca. 1895 and currently used as a law office. The house has a continuous brick foundation, a gable roof of asphalt shingles, an interior brick chimney and an exterior of weatherboard siding. On the main (N) façade a hipped roof canopy supported by large wooden brackets extends across the gable bay below which is a large multi-light picture window and the main entrance, which has a ca. 1990, glass and wood door. This porch was original a single-story according to the 1924 Sanborn Fire Insurance map and was enclosed and the second story added ca. 1940. Windows in the dwelling are original, four-over-four double hung wood sash. On the east elevation is a small, hipped roof, bay window with a central multi-light window flanked by six-over-six double hung wood sash windows.
