

# **PROCLAMATION**

## **37<sup>th</sup> Annual Barrington Area Crop Hunger Walk October 13, 2019**

**WHEREAS**, fifteen Barrington area churches and numerous schools and civic organizations will be conducting the 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Barrington Area CROP Hunger Walk, Sunday, October 13, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, funds raised in this **Walk** will assist, in part, local relief agencies, including Northern Illinois Food Bank, the FISH Food Pantry-Carpentersville, Barrington Meals with Wheels, Wauconda-Island Lake Food Pantry, Wauconda Summer Lunch Program, Project HOPE and the People in Need (PIN) Program of the Barrington Ministerial Association; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds, in part, also go to the Church World Service to provide national and international relief, development, and refugee resettlement; and

**WHEREAS**, Barrington and neighboring communities have faithfully supported CROP Hunger Walks and Church World Service by raising more than \$1,490,000 in the previous thirty-six Walks.
