PREMIUM COMMUTER PARKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Effective 8/21/2019)

- 1. The entire \$1,200 fee must be paid in full by September 15, 2019 or your spot will be released to the waiting list. Permits will be mailed to paid applicants on September 16, 2019 and will be effective on October 1, 2019 for one year.
- 2. Premium permits are non-transferrable and cannot be resold.
- 3. Permits will be issued on an annual basis. Should you need to forgo your spot at any point during the year, your fee will be prorated to the first of the next month. Your permit must be returned to Village Hall prior to a refund being processed.
- 4. You may indicate up to two (2) license plate numbers from your household that will be able to use your premium parking spot. Premium Commuter Parkers must park in their assigned spot and display the permit that will be mailed to you.
- 5. Your Premium Commuter Parking Permit is contingent upon the availability of designated premium spaces. You are not guaranteed to be assigned a spot within your preferred zone. If there are more applicants than available spaces, the Village will maintain a waiting list.
- 6. A Premium Commuter Parking Permit guarantees that your individual space will be available to you until 9:30 a.m. each day of the work week (Monday-Friday). After 9:30 a.m., your space will be released to other commuters. You will NOT be charged to park in any other open spot in the lot if your space has been illegally taken by another parker before 9:30 a.m.
- 7. The Premium Commuter Permit is limited to the North and South Commuter lots. Use of these lots is restricted to the hours between 5:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. the following day, Monday through Friday, subject to additional conditions outlined below:
 - a. **Overnight Parking:** All premium parkers must vacate their Premium Commuter Parking spots by 2:00 a.m. Should you wish to park overnight, you must indicate as such *in advance* via your Passport app or at www.ppprk.com. There is a \$10 fee per overnight; a maximum of three (3) consecutive overnights is allowed.
 - b. *Weekend Parking:* Weekend parking is open to the public; your Premium Commuter Parking Permit is not valid on weekends. However, if you are already parked in your space on a Friday, you may leave your vehicle parked in your space over the weekend from 5:00 p.m. Friday through 5:00 a.m. Monday, except during snowfall or special events (please see below).
 - c. **Snowfall or Special Events:** Parking in **all** Commuter Lots is prohibited during any snowfall clean-up operations and at any other time in which notice is given that the lot will not be available due to maintenance or special events. We make every effort to plow and clean up the Commuter Lots between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. to allow our commuters time to remove their vehicles during snow events so that they will not be towed.
- 8. The use of Municipal Off-Street Parking Lots operated by the Village of Barrington shall be subject to such regulations adopted by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington as they deem necessary, and as such regulations may be modified, amended or repealed from time to time.
- 9. There will be a \$10.00 fee for a replacement permit.
