DECLARATION OF DISASTER AND LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (“WHO”) has declared the 2019 Novel Coronavirus, named COVID-19, which is a highly communicable emerging respiratory disease, a global public health emergency and a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control (“CDC”) has recommended that public officials consider modifying, postponing, or canceling large or mass gatherings for the safety and well-being of event staff, participants and the community and to help prevent the spread and transmission of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, this Order incorporates by reference the Disaster Proclamation by Illinois Governor J. B. Pritzker dated Monday, March 9, 2020, and the conditions and findings thereof:

WHEREAS, Section 65 ILCS 5/11-1-6 of the Illinois Municipal Code provides in relevant part that the corporate authorities of each municipality may by ordinance grant to the Village President the extraordinary power and authority to exercise, by executive order, during a state of emergency, such of the powers of the Corporate Authorities as may be reasonably necessary to respond to the emergency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 11 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/11, I, as Village President of the Village of Barrington, hereby find that a disaster and state of emergency exists within the Village of Barrington and declare this Village a disaster area:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, DECLARED, AND ORDERED by the Village President of the Village of Barrington, Cook and Lake Counties, Illinois, as follows:

1. The recitals set forth in the preamble of this Declaration are hereby made part hereof as the conditions of and findings of fact in support of this Declaration.
2. That a local state of disaster and state of emergency is hereby declared for the Village of Barrington pursuant to 20 ILCS 3305/11.
3. This declared state of emergency shall expire not later than the adjournment of the first regular meeting of the Corporate Authorities after the date of this Declaration and shall not be continued or renewed in excess of seven (7) days, except by or with the consent of the Corporate Authorities of this Village.
4. Pursuant to 20 ILCS 3305/11, this Declaration of a local state of disaster and state of emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Village Clerk.

5. Pursuant to 20 ILCS 3305/11, this Declaration of a local state of disaster and state of emergency activates the Emergency Management Plan of the Village of Barrington and the Continuity of Operations Plan of the Village of Barrington as respectively provided in Section 2-1-13 and 2-1-14 of the Barrington Village Code.
6. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED as follows: That this Declaration shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
