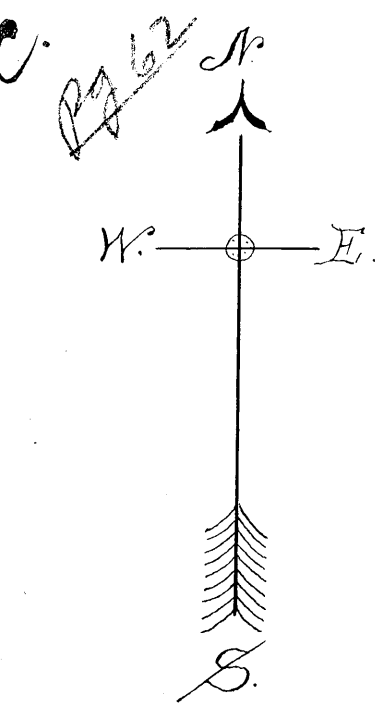


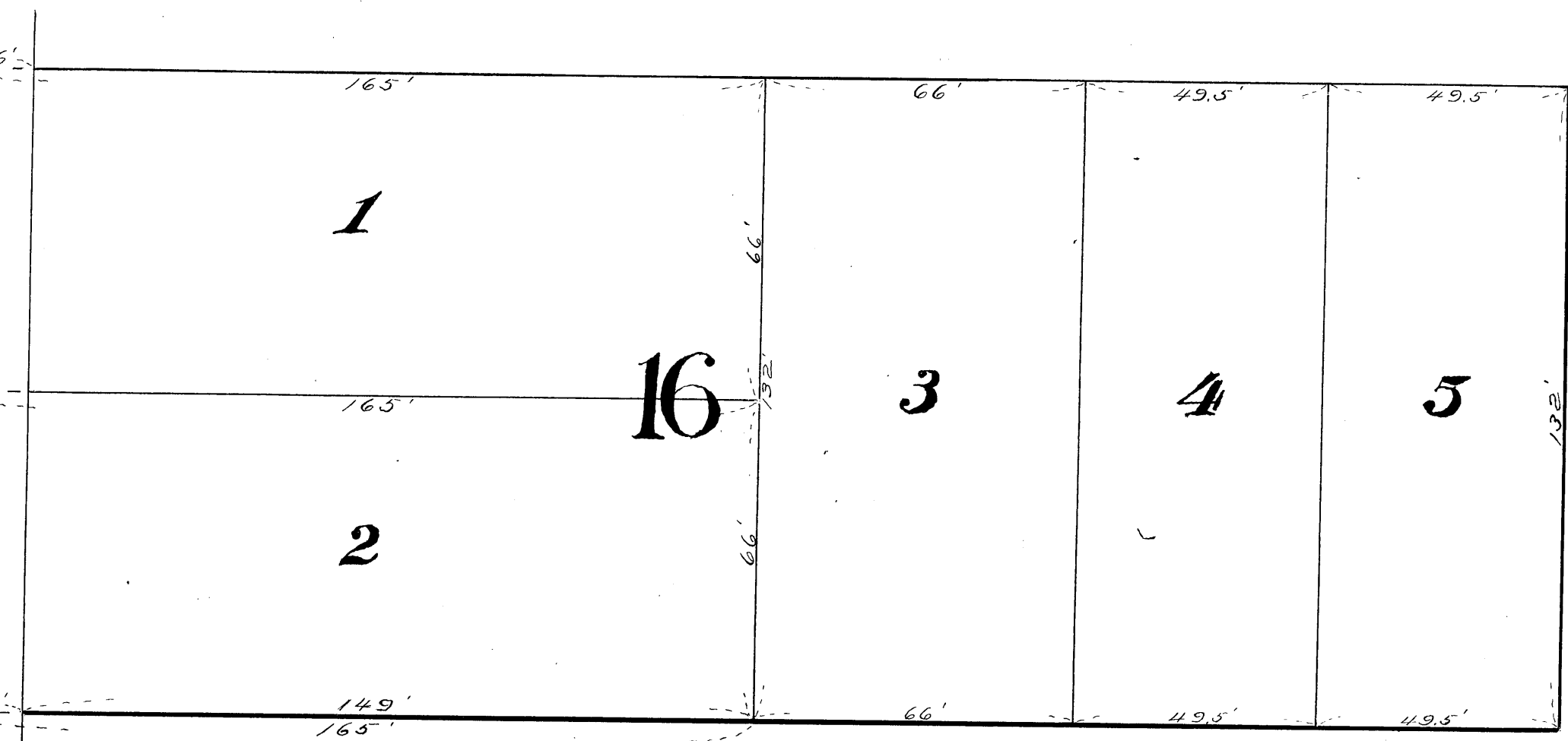

This is to certify that I have surveyed and subdivided Lot 16 of the County Clerk's Division of the West half (1/2) of the South East Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty Six (36) in Township Forty three (43) North, Range Nine (9) East of the Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Principal Meridian, Lake County, Illinois, and that the above plat correctly represents the same, the foot being the unit of measurement thereof.

NOTE:- The North & South Quarter Section line of Section 36 T. 43 N. R. 9 E. of the 3<sup>rd</sup> P.M. is erroneously located on the recorded plat of the Town of Cuba as being 33 feet East of the South East corner of Lot 1. of Blk. 'K' of said plat; the true line being 44 feet East of said corner.  
When making the County Clerk's Division of the West 1/2 of the South East 1/4 of said Section 36, I was instructed by the Original Grantor of said Lot 16 to locate the West line of Lot 16 upon the true Quarter Section line instead of 33 feet East of the South East corner of Lot 1. of Blk. 'K' of Town of Cuba as called for in the metes and bounds description of said Lot 16.
