NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATOR'S WEEK

April 10 – 16, 2022 →

WHEREAS, Public Safety Telecommunicators of CenCom E9-1-1 have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fires and treatment of patients; and

WHEREAS, each Telecommunicator has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of his/her job in the past year.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karen Darch, President of the Board of Trustees for the Village of Barrington, Cook and Lake Counties, Illinois, do hereby proclaim April 10-16, 2022, as NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATOR'S WEEK in honor of the men and women whose diligence and professionalism keep our Village and citizens safe.
