Recognizing and Honoring Tyler Francis Jackson on Achieving the Rank of Eagle Scout

WHEREAS, the fact that a boy is an Eagle Scout has always carried with it a special significance, not only in Scouting but also in higher education, business, and community service; and

WHEREAS, the award is a performance-based achievement which represents the highest advancement rank in Scouting; and

WHEREAS, only about three percent of all Boy Scouts earn the rank of Eagle Scout; and

WHEREAS, to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout, Tyler Francis Jackson had to fulfill requirements in the areas of leadership, service and outdoor skills; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the merit badge requirement to become an Eagle Scout, Tyler has earned an additional 21 merit badges, earning him two (2) bronze palms, one (1) gold palm, and one (1) silver palm; and

WHEREAS, For his Eagle Scout Project, Tyler led a team of scouts and adults to aid Flint Creek Wildlife Rehabilitation in cleaning out an abandoned barn, restoring seven (7) cages, and building a shelving system to hold those cages; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Francis Jackson is a proud member of Boy Scout Troop #10 in the Pathway to Adventure Council.
